THE STATE OF NEVADA CERTIFICATE OF APPROPRIATION OF WATER

WHEREAS Mark Chilton, Agent has presented to the State Engineer of the State of Nevada Proof of Application of Water to Beneficial Use, from an underground source through drilled well, pump and irrigation system for irrigation purposes. The point of diversion of water from the source is as follows: SW¹ SE¹ Section 19, T. 33N. R. 48E., M.D.R.&M., or at a point from which the N¹ corner of said Section 19 bears N. 16° 17' 53" W. a distance of 4,554.34 feet. situated in Eureka County, State of Nevada.

Now KNOW YE, That the State Engineer, under the provisions of Sec. 72, Ch. 46, Statutes of 1937 NRS 533.425 has determined the date, source, purpose, amount of appropriation, and the place where such water is appurtenant, as follows:

*This certificate is issued subject to the terms of the permit and with the understanding that the total duty of water for the land under this certificate shall not exceed 3.0 ac. ft. per acre annually from all sources.

The point of diversion is located in Eureka County and the place of use is in Lander County. This certificate must be recorded in both counties.

The right to water hereby determined is limited to the amount which can be beneficially used, not to exceed the amount above specified, and the use is restricted to the place and for the purpose as set forth herein.
