Bitch Right-of-Way Act of February 15, 1901

RIGHT-OF-WAY GRANT AMENDED

By letter of August 6, 1965, the Vice President of the Ruby Hill Mining Company requested a five-year extension of time to complete construction of the ditch authorized in the above-noted right-of-way grant, and to file proof of construction thereof. Justification for the extension of time was set out in historical and technical detail.

The application for an additional period to construct was timely filed and the reasons given for delay in constructing the works during the first five-year period allowed are sufficient justification to grant the request. Accordingly, the grant of right-of-way dated October 6, 1960, is amended to allow ten years from the date of grant in which to file proof of construction.

Amendment of the grant is subject, however, to all valid rights as of October 6, 1960, and to any valid rights that may have been established subsequent to that date.

Ruby Hill Mining Company is allowed the right of appeal to the Director, Bureau of Land Management, in accordance with the regulations in 43 CFR Subpart 1842. See enclosed Circular 2137 and Form 1842-1. If an appeal is taken, it must be filed in the Land Office, Bureau of Land Management, Reno, Nevada, and the amount of the filing fee will be \$5. In taking an appeal there must be strict compliance with the regulations. If an appeal is filed, you will have the burden of proving by presenting positive and substantial evidence wherein the decision appealed from is in error.
