

Certificate of Location

This Is to Certify, That a mining claim named the Fib #4 was located by

Charles Damele, Charles Damele Jr.,
Ronald Damele, Jack O'Connor
on the 20th day of March 1968, situated in
Unknown District, Eureka County, State of
Nevada, and about 2 miles east of Willow Cr. Ranch

The north side line of this claim is common
with the south side line of Fib #3

(Refer to some natural object or permanent monument)

We claim 1500 linear feet along the course of
mineral bearing ledge, lode or vein, extending 10 feet from the
location monument in a easterly direction, and 1490
feet in a westerly direction, together with 300 feet
on each side of the center of the ledge for the entire length of the claim.

The discovery work consists of Rotary Drill Hole
(Shaft, cut or tunnel)

situated about 400 feet in a N65W direction from the location
monument of Fib #3 and its dimensions are 5 inch feet wide,
36.5 feet long and 36.5 feet deep, exposing ledge, lode or vein in place.

The northwest corner is marked by a post 4"x4"x4 feet high, inscribed
"N. W. corner Fib #4 Mine"; the southwest corner is marked by a
post 4"x4"x4 feet high, inscribed "S. W. corner Fib #4
Mine"; the southeast corner is marked by a post 4"x4"x4 feet high,
inscribed "S. E. corner Fib #4 Mine"; the northeast corner is
marked by a post 4"x4"x4 feet high, inscribed "N. E. corner
Fib #4 Mine." There is also a 4"x4"x4 post at

the center of each side line. The discovery work has been done and the location completed since
June 5 1968.
