

## Certificate of Location

This Is to Certify, That a mining claim named the Fili #6

We claim 1500 linear feet along the course of  
mineral bearing ledge, lode or vein, extending 10 feet from the  
location monument in a easterly direction, and 1490  
feet in a westerly direction, together with 300 feet  
on each side of the center of the ledge for the entire length of the claim.The discovery work consists of Rotary Drill Hole  
(Shaft, cut or tunnel)  
situated about 1000 feet in a N 50W direction from the location  
monument and its dimensions are 5 inch feet wide, feet high,  
feet long and 200 feet deep, exposing ledge, lode or vein in place.The northwest corner is marked by a post 4"x4"x4 feet high, inscribed  
"N. W. corner Fili #6 Mine"; the southwest corner is marked by a  
post 4"x4"x4 feet high, inscribed "S. W. corner Fili #6  
Mine"; the southeast corner is marked by a post 4"x4"x4 feet high,  
inscribed "S. E. corner Fili #6 Mine"; the northeast corner is  
marked by a post 4"x4"x4 feet high, inscribed "N. E. corner  
Fili #6 Mine." There is also a 4"x4"x4 post atthe center of each side line. The discovery work has been done and the location completed since
