

# Certificate of Location

This Is to Certify, That a mining claim named the Fifi #9

was located by

Nevada, and about 2 miles east of Willow Cr. Ranch.

The west end line of this claim is common

We claim 1500 linear feet along the course of

mineral bearing ledge, lode or vein, extending 10 feet from the

location monument in a westerly direction, and 1490

feet in a easterly direction, together with 300 feet

on each side of the center of the ledge for the entire length of the claim.

The discovery work consists of Rotary Drill Hole  
(Shaft, cut or tunnel)

situated about 300 feet in a N70E direction from the location

monument and its dimensions are 5 inch feet wide, feet high,

feet long and 365 feet deep, exposing ledge, lode or vein in place.

The northwest corner is marked by a post 4"x4"x4 feet high, inscribed

"N. W. corner Fifi #9 Mine"; the southwest corner is marked by a

post 4"x4"x4 feet high, inscribed "S. W. corner Fifi #9

Mine"; the southeast corner is marked by a post 4"x4"x4 feet high,

inscribed "S. E. corner Fifi #9 Mine"; the northeast corner is

marked by a post 4"x4"x4 feet high, inscribed "N. E. corner

Fifi #9 Mine." There is also a 4"x4"x4' post at

the center of each side line. The discovery work has been done and the location completed since

June 5 1968.
