

Certificate of Location

This Is to Certify, That a mining claim named the Fif # 11 was located by

Charles Damele, Charles Damele Jr.,
Ronald Damele, Jack O'Connor

on the 20th day of March 1968, situated in

Unknown District, Eureka County, State of
Nevada, and about 2 miles east of Willow Cr. Ranch.

The west end line of this claim is common
with the east end line of Fif # 2

(Refer to some natural object or permanent monument)

We claim 1500 linear feet along the course of
mineral bearing ledge, lode or vein, extending 10 feet from the
location monument in a westerly direction, and 1490
feet in a easterly direction, together with 300 feet
on each side of the center of the ledge for the entire length of the claim.

The discovery work consists of Balany Drill Hole
(Shaft, cut or tunnel)
situated about 300 feet in a N70E direction from the location
monument and its dimensions are 5 inch feet wide, _____ feet high,
_____ feet long and 36.5 feet deep, exposing ledge, lode or vein in place.

The northwest corner is marked by a post 4" x 4" x 4 feet high, inscribed
"N. W. corner Fif # 11 Mine"; the southwest corner is marked by a
post 4" x 4" x 4 feet high, inscribed "S. W. corner Fif # 11
Mine"; the southeast corner is marked by a post 4" x 4" x 4 feet high,
inscribed "S. E. corner Fif # 11 Mine"; the northeast corner is
marked by a post 4" x 4" x 4 feet high, inscribed "N. E. corner
Fif # 11 Mine." There is also a 4" x 4" x 4 post at
the center of each side line. The discovery work has been done and the location completed since

June 5 1968.
