

Certificate of Location

This Is to Certify, That a mining claim named the Fil #17 was located by

we claim 1500 linear feet along the course of

mineral bearing ledge, lode or vein, extending 10 feet from the

location monument in a westerly direction, and 1490

feet in a easterly direction, together with 300 feet

on each side of the center of the ledge for the entire length of the claim.

The discovery work consists of Rotary Drill Hole

(Shaft, cut or tunnel)

situated about 60 feet in a N 70 E direction from the location

monument and its dimensions are 5 inch feet wide, 5 feet high,

265 feet long and 265 feet deep, exposing ledge, lode or vein in place.

The northwest corner is marked by a post 4"x4"x4 feet high, inscribed

"N. W. corner Fil #17 Mine"; the southwest corner is marked by a

post 4"x4"x4 feet high, inscribed "S. W. corner Fil #17

Mine"; the southeast corner is marked by a post 4"x4"x4 feet high,

inscribed "S. E. corner Fil #17 Mine"; the northeast corner is

marked by a post 4"x4"x4 feet high, inscribed "N. E. corner

Fil #17 Mine." There is also a 4"x4"x4' post at

the center of each side line. The discovery work has been done and the location completed since
