We claim 1500 linear feet along the course ofmineral bearing ledge, lode or vein, extending 10 feet from thelocation monument in a westerly direction, and 1490feet in a easterly direction, together with 300 feet

on each side of the center of the ledge for the entire length of the claim.

The discovery work consists of Rotary Drill Hole
(Shaft, cut or tunnel)situated about 60 feet in a N70E direction from the locationmonument and its dimensions are 5 inch feet wide, feet high,feet long and 26.5 feet deep, exposing ledge, lode or vein in place.The northwest corner is marked by a post 4"x4"x4 feet high, inscribed"N. W. corner Fip #18 Mine"; the southwest corner is marked by apost 4"x4"x4 feet high, inscribed "S. W. corner Fip #18Mine"; the southeast corner is marked by a post 4"x4"x4 feet high,inscribed "S. E. corner Fip #18 Mine"; the northeast corner ismarked by a post 4"x4"x4 feet high, inscribed "N. E. cornerFip #18 Mine". There is also a 4"x4"x4 post at

the center of each side line. The discovery work has been done and the location completed since
