

## Certificate of Location

This Is to Certify, That a mining claim named the Fip #20 was located by

Charles Damele Sr., Charles Damele Jr.,  
Ronald Damele, & Jack O'Connor  
on the 18<sup>th</sup> day of April 1968, situated in  
Antelope District, Eureka County, State of  
Nevada, and about 3 miles east of Willow Cr. Ranch  
The south side line of this claim is common  
with the north side line of Fip #19.

(Refer to some natural object or permanent monument)

We claim 1500 linear feet along the course of  
mineral bearing ledge, lode or vein, extending 750 feet from the  
location monument in a easterly direction, and 750  
feet in a westerly direction, together with ~~1500~~ 300 feet  
on each side of the center of the ledge for the entire length of the claim.

The discovery work consists of Rotary Drill Hole  
(Shaft, cut or tunnel)  
situated about 350 feet in a N60E direction from the location  
monument of Fip #15 and its dimensions are 5 inch feet wide, feet high,  
feet long and 24.5 feet deep, exposing ledge, lode or vein in place.

The northwest corner is marked by a post 4"x4"x4 feet high, inscribed  
"N. W. corner Fip #20 Mine"; the southwest corner is marked by a  
post 4"x4"x4 feet high, inscribed "S. W. corner Fip #20  
Mine"; the southeast corner is marked by a post 4"x4"x4 feet high,  
inscribed "S. E. corner Fip #20 Mine"; the northeast corner is  
marked by a post 4"x4"x4 feet high, inscribed "N. E. corner  
Fip #20 Mine." There is also a 4"x4"x4 post at

the center of each side line. The discovery work has been done and the location completed since
