

Certificate of Location

LODE OR QUARTZ

THIS IS TO CERTIFY that a mining claim Panick Mine No. Two was located by Alvin W. & Elva G. Doe

on the 20 day of June, 1968, situate in Mineral
Hill Mining District, Eureka County, State of
Nevada and about 35 miles in a Northerly
direction from town of Eureka and about 4 1/2
miles in a North Easterly direction from
So. end of Table Mt. and about 1 1/2 miles
in a Westerly direction from Sulphur
Spr. Mts. 1500

We (~~we~~) claim ~~600~~ linear feet along the course of the mineral-bearing ledge, lode or vein, extending ~~300~~ 750 feet from the location monument in a Southerly direction, and ~~300~~ 750 feet in a Northerly direction, together with ~~300~~ 300 feet on each side of the center of the ledge for the entire length of the claim.

The discovery work consists of a Open Hole located about 25 or 30 feet in a Northerly direction from the location monument, and its dimensions are 6 feet wide, 8 feet long and 5 feet deep, exposing ledge, lode or vein in place.

The northwest corner is marked by a 4 x 4 x 6 feet high, inscribed "NW Corner of the No. Two Claim;" the southwest corner is marked by a 4 x 4 x 6 feet high, inscribed "SW Corner of the No. Two Claim;" the southeast corner is marked by a 4 x 4 x 6 feet high, inscribed "SE Corner of the No. Two Claim;" the northeast corner is marked by a 4 x 4 x 6 feet high, inscribed "NE Corner of the No. Two Claim." There is also a post at the center of each side line. The discovery work has been done, and the location completed since June 19, 1968.
