JOINT TENANCY DEED

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THIS INDENTURE, made the 13th day of August, 1959, by and between EUDORA V. That the said Party of the First Part, in consideration of the sum of TEN AND NO/100 DOLLARS (\$10.00), lawful money of the United States of America, to her in hand paid by the said Parties of the Second Part, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, does by these presents grant, bargain, sell, remise, release, and forever QUITCLAIM unto the Parties of the Second Part, in joint tenancy, and to the survivor of them, and to the heirs and assigns of such survivor forever, all those certain patented lode mining claims situated in the BUCKHORN MINING DISTRICT of the County of Eureka, State of Nevada, bounded and described as follows, to-wit:

The BUCKHORN No. 10, HUMBOLDT No. 1, HUMBOLDT No. 2, LAME BULL No. 2 and LAME BULL FRACTION, situate in the Buckhorn Mining District of the County of Eureka, State of Nevada.

TOGETHER with all the rights, privileges, and franchises thereto incident, appendant and appurtenant, or therewith usually had and enjoyed, and all and singular the tenements, hereditaments and appurtenances thereto belonging or in anywise appertaining, and the rents, issues and profits thereof.

TO HAVE AND TO HOLD the said premises, appurtenances and privileges, unto the Parties of the Second Part, as joint tenants, and not as tenants in common, with right of survivorship, and to the heirs and assigns of such survivor forever.
