

CERTIFICATE OF LOCATION—LODE CLAIMS
RELOCATION OF ABANDONED CLAIMS

THIS IS TO CERTIFY, That 2 mining claims named the Lois # 3 and the Lois # 4 were located by James V. Muth agent for G. M. WALLACE & COMPANY whose address is 7895 East Prentice Avenue, Englewood, Colorado on the following dates: May 27, 1968

The claims are situated in Maggie Creek District, Eureka County, State of Nevada, and are more specifically located (see accompanying sketch) in the NW 1/4 Sec. 22, T. 34 N., R. 51 E., Mount Diablo Meridian. Lois # 3 has common boundary on the south with Ellen # 5 and on the east with Lois # 4. Lois # 4 has a common boundary on the south with Ellen # 10 and on the west with Lois # 3. The west boundary of Lois # 3 is common to the west sideline of Section 22 and the north boundary is located 3600 feet north of the south sideline of section 22. The claims are contiguous and are re-named and re-located over abandoned lode mining claims Element Nos. 74 & 81.

The general course of the lodes or veins is easterly and westerly

The locator claims 1500 linear feet per claim along the course of mineral bearing ledges, lodes, or veins, extending as shown on the sketch, together with 300 feet on each side of the centers of the ledges for the entire length of the claims. The discovery work consists of bulldozer trenches located immediately north of the location monuments of each claim with each trench having dimensions greater than 4 feet by six feet by ten feet.



There is also a post 4 feet high at the center of each side line. The discovery work costing at least \$200.00 has been done and the location completed since May 27, 1968

State of Nevada, and are more specifically located (see accompanying sketch) to include all
of the southwest quarter of section 22 T. 34 N., R. 51 E., Mount Diablo meridian,
and the overlapping parts of the NW 1/4, NE 1/4 and SE 1/4 of the same section 22.
The claims are contiguous and represent re-location and re-naming of claims
previously named and located as Element Nos. 69 thru 73 and nos. 82 thru 86.
These previous claims are abandoned.

The general course of the lodes or veins is easterly and westerly.


The locator claims 1500 linear feet per claim along the course of mineral
bearing ledges, lodes, or veins, extending as shown on the sketch, together with 300 feet on
each side of the centers of the ledges for the entire length of the claims. The discovery work
consists of 140 feet of 5 1/2 inch diameter hole drilled at a point 42 feet east
of the location monument on the Ellen # 1 claim. Extensive bulldozer work
was completed along a line just east of the center of claims Ellen # 1 thru
Ellen # 4, as shown on the sketch, exposing ledge, lode, or vein in place.
The work described tends to advance the exploration of all claims as a group.
The northwest corners are marked by posts 4 feet high, inscribed "N. W. corner of
corresponding claim"; the southwest corners are marked by posts 4 feet high, inscribed
"S. W. corner of corresponding claim"; the southeast corners are marked by posts 4 feet
high, inscribed "S. E. corner of corresponding claim"; the northeast corners are marked by
posts 4 feet high, inscribed "N. E. Corner of corresponding claim". There is also a post 4
feet high at the center of each side line. The discovery work costing at least \$1,000.00 has
been done and the location completed since May 15, 1968.
