

That such work consisted of a geological and geochemical survey on Shirl No.'s 21, 23, 25, 27, 29. The samples were analyzed for gold by atomic absorption spectrophotometry by Rocky Mountain Geochemical Corporation, Salt Lake City, and Skyline Labs, Inc., Denver. The geochemical survey, consisting of both grid and detailed sampling, showed a series of gold anomalies. The geochemical and geological survey was conducted by Lyle F. Campbell, Box 7377, Reno, Nevada, a B.S., Mining Engineering, graduate of the University of Minnesota, and a graduate

of the Colorado School of Mines short course in geochemistry who has been practicing his pfoession for 19 years.
