## CERTIFICATE OF MINING LOCATION

TO ALL WHOM IT MAY CONCERN


The undersigned hereby certifies that he has located the BENNARK NO.24 Mining Claim in the unknown Mining District, in Eureka County, in the State of Newada, on the 20th of July 1968, at 11:15 a.m.

The length of the claim is 1500 feet, and 142 claimed in northwesterly direction, and 1358 feet in an southeasterly direction from the discovery monument, at which the notice of location is posted, lengthwise of the claim, together with 300 feet in width on each side of the center of the claim. The general course of the lode deposit and premises is from the South 48 East to North 48 West.

The location of the claim is described with reference to the SE corner of Section 23, T22N, R50B, Nount Biablo Meridian, which bears about S 52°R, about 11,200 feet, from corner no. 1 of BENNARK NO. 24 Claim. Corner no. 1 of Benmark No. 24 Claim is identical with corner no. 4 of Benmark No. 16 Claim.

The surface boundaries of the claim are marked upon the ground as follows: Beginning at a point in a N 48°W direction 142 feet from the discovery monument (at which the notice of location is posted), being in the center of the west end line of said claim; thence N 42°B,300 feet to a 4" dia, 4½' hi, juniper being the NW No. 1 corner of said claim; thence S 48°B, 750 feet to a 4" x 4½' hi, redwood post being at the center of the north side line; thence S 48°B, 750 feet to a 8" dia, 5' hi, topped juniper post being the NE No. 2 corner of said claim; thence S 42°W, 300 feet to the center of the east end line of said claim; thence S 42°W, 300 feet to a 8" dia, 6' hi, topped pinon tree being the SE No. 3 corner of said claim; thence N 48°W, 750 feet to a 5½" dia, 6' hi, pinon tree, topped, being at the center of the south side line; thence N 48°W, 750 feet to a 6" dia, 6' hi, juniper post being the SW No. 4 corner of said claim; thence N 42°E, 300 feet to the center of the west end line of said claim, at the place of beginning. Metal tags, marked with appropriate corner descriptions, as described above, are affixed to the monuments. The boundaries of the claim were completed July 30 , 1968. A description and the location of the work done upon the claim is as follows: An open cut and excavation has been dug along the ledge or lode, the size of which is at least 4 feet by 6 feet by 10 feet, located at the discovery monument, and excavation work done at various points on the Benmark No. 24 claim,
