CERTIFICATE OF APPROPRIATION OF WATER

Caselli, Agent, has presented to the State Engineer of the State of Nevada Proof of Application of Water to Beneficial Use, from an underground source through well, pump, and irrigation system for irrigation and domestic purposes. The point of diversion of water from the source is as follows: SW $\frac{1}{4}$ NE $\frac{1}{4}$ Section 15, T. 21N., R. 53E., M.D.B.&M., or at a point from which the S $\frac{1}{4}$ corner of said Section 15 bears S. 1° 04' W., a distance of 2,690.5 feet situated in Eureka County, State of Nevada.

NOW KNOW YE, That the State Engineer, under the provisions of NRS 533.425, has determined the date, source, purpose, amount of appropriation, and the place where such water is appurtenant, as follows:
