

Certificate of Location

This Is to Certify, That a mining claim named the Quartz Hill No. 51

was located by Leo Damele and John Damele of Eureka, Nevada

on the 1st day of August 1968, situated in Antelope District, Eureka County, State of

Nevada, and about 3 miles south of Willow Creek Ranch.
The west side line of this claim is common with the east side line of Quartz Hill No. 60

(Refer to some natural object or permanent monument)

We claim 1500 linear feet along the course of mineral bearing ledge, lode or vein, extending 750 feet from the location monument in a Northerly direction, and 750 feet in a Southerly direction, together with 300 feet on each side of the center of the ledge for the entire length of the claim.

The discovery work consists of Rotary Drill Hole (Shaft, cut or tunnel)

situated about 540 feet in a N7E direction from the location monument and its dimensions are 5" dia feet wide, 5 feet high, 150 feet long and 150 feet deep, exposing ledge, lode or vein in place.

The northwest corner is marked by a 4" x 4" post 4 feet high, inscribed "N. W. corner Quartz Hill No. 51 Mine"; the southwest corner is marked by a 4" x 4" post 4 feet high, inscribed "S. W. corner Quartz Hill No. 51 Mine"; the southeast corner is marked by a 4" x 4" post 4 feet high, inscribed "S. E. corner Quartz Hill No. 51 Mine"; the northeast corner is marked by a 4" x 4" post 4 feet high, inscribed "N. E. corner Quartz Hill No. 51 Mine." There is also a 4" x 4" post 4' high at the center of each side line. The discovery work has been done and the location completed since

Oct 5 1968.
