

# Certificate of Location

This Is to Certify, That a mining claim named the FIP # 53

was located by  
Charles Damele Sr., Charles Damele Jr., Ronald Damele  
Jack O'Connor all of Eureka, Nevada  
on the 17<sup>th</sup> day of August 1968, situated in  
Unknown District, Eureka County, State of  
Nevada, and about One mile east of Willow Cr. Ranch  
& the north side line is common with the south  
side line of FIP # 52.

(Refer to some natural object or permanent monument)

We claim 1500 linear feet along the course of  
mineral bearing ledge, lode or vein, extending 1490 feet from the  
location monument in a easterly direction, and 10  
feet in a westerly direction, together with 300 feet  
on each side of the center of the ledge for the entire length of the claim.

The discovery work consists of cut  
(Shaft, cut or tunnel)  
situated about 10 feet in a easterly direction from the location  
monument and its dimensions are 10 feet wide, 10 feet high,  
10 feet long and 3 feet deep, exposing ledge, lode or vein in place.

The northwest corner is marked by a post 4"x4"x4 feet high, inscribed  
"N. W. corner FIP # 53 Mine"; the southwest corner is marked by a  
post 4"x4"x4 feet high, inscribed "S. W. corner FIP # 53  
Mine"; the southeast corner is marked by a post 4"x4"x4 feet high,  
inscribed "S. E. corner FIP # 53 Mine"; the northeast corner is  
marked by a post 4"x4"x4 feet high, inscribed "N. E. corner  
FIP # 53 Mine." There is also a 4"x4"x4' post at  
the center of each side line. The discovery work has been done and the location completed since

November 12 1968.
