## GEOLOGIC REPORT

## FOURNILE CANYON AREA, CORTEZ RANGE, EUREKA COUNTY, NEVADA

For and with respect to the assessment year September 1, 1967 to September 1, 1968, geological and geochemical surveys were conducted as directed by Robert L. Redmond, Manager for Martel Mining Company, upon the Falcon, Pat, Ina, and End Group of contiguous mining claims located in Fourmile Canyon, Cortez Range, Eureka County, Nevada. Such work was done at the instance and expense of the Martel Mining Company as directed by Robert L. Redmond.

Such work and surveys consisted of delineating geologic structures in more details, logging drill cores from FM-7 and FM-9 drill holes, geochemical sampling of drill cores, and geochemical surveys for gold on part of the Falcon and Pat mining claims as shown on the geochemical map accompanying the detailed report dated January 31, 1968.

The basic findings from such surveys were: (1) certain areas in Fourmile appear to be anomalous for gold, (2) these anomalous areas appear to coincide with arsenic anomalies, (3) small amounts of gold was found in drill holes Nos. 7 and 9 associated with arsenopyrite, and (4) these anomalies appear to be spatially and genetically(?) associated with quartz-porphyry intrusives.

Such work was performed by Edmond F. Lawrence, Mining Geologist, assisted by E.L. Stephenson, Consulting Mining Geologist, Robert L. Redmond, Geologist, John H. Volgamore, Geologist, H.J. Lawrence, and Johnie Yarn.

Edmond F. Lawrence is a mining geologist, holding a B.S. degree in geology from the University of Alabama, and a M.S. degree in geology from the University of California at Los Angeles. His experience includes six years as a mining geologist with the Anaconda Company and the Idaho Maryland Mines Company, six years as a mining geologist for the Nevada Bureau of Mines, and seven years as a consulting mining geologist.
