It appearing that the allegations of said Petition are true, and the action of Albert Silver, Trustee, should be approved, it is


HEREBY ORDERED: That the action of Albert Silver, Trustee in terminating the contract of sale with Al Russell be, and the same hereby is approved; and it is

5 sale of the property, two insertions being sufficient; and three  
6 insertions in a Reno newspaper for said period which will be suf-

IT APPEARING that in the above matter the United States  
District Court for the District of Nevada, Hon. Frank H. Norcross  
presiding, on May 2, 1945, caused said corporation to be  
adjudicated a bankrupt; that thereafter on June 15, 1945, the  
first meeting of creditors was held; that at that time William S.  
Boyle was selected as trustee, and that he remained as such  
trustee until September 15, 1949, when he died, that a meeting  
of creditors was held on October 18, 1949, and at that time Albert  
Silver was selected as trustee, and he ever since has remained as  
trustee, and said court authorized said trustee to retain Edward  
P. Treadwell and James T. Boyd as his attorneys, and they were so  
retained and have acted as such ever since said time; that said  
court, by Hon. Roger T. Foley, made its order on June 27, 1953,  
directing that said estate be liquidated in bankruptcy; that  
Frank W. Ingram, Referee in Bankruptcy for the District of Nevada,  
being unable to perform the duties of Referee due to illness, and  
the Chief Judge of the United States Court of Appeals for the

1 Ninth Circuit having designated the undersigned to act as Referee  
2 in said matter; and a meeting of creditors having been held on the  
3 24th day of August, 1953, said Referee presiding, and he being  
4 now fully advised in the premises,

5 IT IS ORDERED that the said ALBERT SILVER be continued  
6 as Trustee in said matter, under the bond given by him and ap-  
7 proved by the court, and subject to said order authorizing said  
8 trustee to retain said Edward F. Treadwell and James T. Boyd as  
9 his attorneys, and subject to the action of said trustee retaining  
10 said attorneys;

11 IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that said trustee will with all  
12 convenient dispatch liquidate the said estate in accordance with  
13 the order of said court dated June 27, 1953.
