

53-A—REAL ESTATE MORTGAGE—With Tax Clause (Revised 1962)

KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS: THAT ALFRED W. KRUEGER and GRACE EDITH KRUEGER, husband and wife, each in his and her own right and as spouse of the other (Mortgagor) of Howard County, and State of Nebraska , in consideration of the sum of Twenty-Four Thousand Six Hundred Seventy-Nine --- & --- 64/100 ----- DOLLARS in hand paid, do hereby SELL and CONVEY unto

ST. PAUL NATIONAL BANK (Mortgagee) of Howard County, and State of Nebraska the following described premises situated in Eureka County, and State of Nevada to-wit:

Section 33, Lots One (1), Two (2), South Half (S½) Northeast Quarter (NE¼), Southeast Quarter (SE¼), Township 21½, N., Range Fifty-Four East (54E), Mount Diablo Meridian, Eureka County, Nevada

The intention being to convey hereby an absolute title in fee simple including all the rights of homestead and dower. bearing even date with these presents, and shall pay all taxes and assessments levied upon said real estate, and all other taxes, levies and assessments levied upon this mortgage or the note which this mortgage is given to secure, before the same becomes delinquent, and keep the buildings on said premises insured for the sum of \$ loss, if any, payable to the said mortgagee, then these presents to be void, otherwise to be and remain in full force.

IT IS FURTHER AGREED (1) That if the said mortgagor shall fail to pay such taxes or procure such insurance, the said mortgagee may pay such taxes and procure such insurance; and the sum so advanced, with interest at per cent shall be paid by said mortgagor, and this mortgage shall stand as security for the same.
