

**QUARTZ****NOTICE OF LOCATION**

Notice is hereby given that the undersigned citizen as of the United States hereby locate \_\_\_\_\_ and claim \_\_\_\_\_ the following described piece of mineral bearing ground as a ledge mining claim,
