 The Southwest corner^s are marked by a 4x4 Posts Four feet high and inscribed southwest corner of Lawton-Eldorado #1, 2, 3, 4 & 5 mine.
 The Southeast corner^s are marked by 4x4 Posts - Four feet high, inscribed Southeast corner^s Same mine. the Northeast corner is marked by a 4x4 Posts -- Four feet high, inscribed Northeast corner of Lawton-Eldorado #1, 2, 3, 4 & 5 mines. There is a 4x4 Post four feet high at each corner of each line. The discovery work has been done and the location work completed since 28TH DAY - OF - JULY A. D. 1969
