Said labor was performed during the period between September 1, 1968, and August 31, 1969.

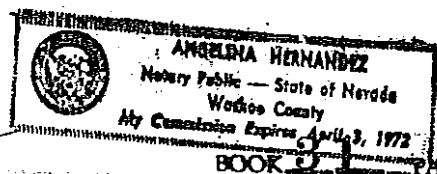
That such work consisted of geologic mapping and a geochemical survey of soil, rocks and sediments. This work was non-repetitive of any previous work done on the same claims. All samples were analyzed for gold and silver by atomic absorption spectrophotometry and other trace elements by colorimetric methods by Skyline Labs, Inc., Denver, Colorado. The survey showed anomalous values in gold, silver, arsenic and mercury. The survey was conducted with the cognizance and approval of Lyle F. Campbell, Box 7377, Reno, Nevada 89502, a B. S., Mining Engineering, graduate of the University of Minnesota, and a graduate of the Colorado School of Mines short course in geochemistry, who has been practicing his profession for twenty years.

That all of said work was done and performed for the benefit of each and all of the unpatented lode mining claims hereinabove named.

That all expenditures were made at the expense of Lyle F. Campbell, and others, for the purpose of complying with the laws of the State of Nevada and the United States in the performance of annual assessment work to maintain title to unpatented lode mining claims; that said work was done for and on behalf of and for the benefit of Lyle F. Campbell, owner of the unpatented lode mining claims above named.
