location work pits deepened, and sampled.Such expenditure was made by or at the expense of Howard E. Harrisowner of said claim S in accordance

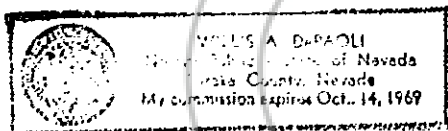
