

CERTIFICATE OF LOCATION

Revised Laws, Sec. 2424

The Undersigned, hereby certifies that they have located a mining claim in the Unknown Mining District, County of Eureka, State of Nevada, on a vein or lode known as the Twenty to One #2.

The general course of said lode or vein, as near as it may be described, is North & South.

The names of the locator are: E. L. Cleveland, 1201 Shadow Lane, Las Vegas, Nevada; Dennis Hill, 1201 Shadow Lane, Las Vegas, Nev.; Hugh M. Baldwin, P.O. Box 327, Eureka, Nevada; E. G. Leutzinger, P.O. Box 327, Eureka, Nevada.

The said claim was located on the 15th day of July, A. D. 19 69, and is described in respect to* Approximately 1/4 miles northeasterly from the town of Beowawe, Nevada.

The locator's claim Fifteen Hundred Feet (1,500 Lin. Ft.) feet in length along the course of said vein or lode each way from the point of discovery with a width of Six Hundred 600 Lin. Ft. feet on each side of the center of the vein or lode along the entire length of said claim.

The dimensions and location of the discovery shaft work is: The discovery work has been performed approximately 160 feet northeast of the discovery monument, and is a backhoe excavation of the following dimensions: 7 feet wide, 9 feet long, and 4 1/2 feet deep.

and the location and description of each corner with the markings thereon are as follows:

The Northeast corner is marked by a 4'x4' White Post 4' feet high inscribed NE. COR. corner of Twenty to One #1 mine; the Northwest corner is marked by a 4'x4' White Post 4' feet high inscribed NW. COR. corner of Twenty to One #1 mine. The Southeast corner is marked by 4'x4' White Post 4' feet high, inscribed SE. COR. corner Twenty to One #1 mine; the Southwest corner is marked by a 4'x4' White Post 4' feet high, inscribed SW. COR. corner Twenty to One #1 mine. There is a 4'x4' White Post 300 feet each side of the center of claim as side-centers at each corner of each line. The discovery work has been done and the location work completed since July 29th, A. D. 19 69.
