

CERTIFICATE OF LOCATION

The locators claim 1500 feet in length

along the course of said vein or lode each way from the point of discovery with a width of 600 feet on each side of the center of the vein or lode along the entire length of said claim.

The dimensions and location of the discovery shaft work is Discovery work is located approximately 250 East of the discovery monument and is a Backhoe excavation of approx. dimension:- 7' wide, 9' long and 4' deep.

COR. corner BLACKHAWK mine; the Southwest corner is marked by a 4' x 4' White Post 4' feet high, inscribed SW. COR. corner BLACKHAWK mine. There is a 5' x 4' White Post placed out

300-Ft. from the center of claim at each corner of each line. The discovery work has been done and the location work completed since July 29th, 1969
