

# CERTIFICATE OF LOCATION

Revised Laws, Sec. 2424

The Undersigned, hereby certifies that the undersigned have located a mining claim in the Unknown Mining District, County of Eureka, State of Nevada, on a vein or lode known as the BLACKHAWK #3.

The general course of said lode or vein, as near as it may be described, is NORTHERLY & SOUTHERLY.

The names of the locators are: E.L. Cleveland, 1201 Shadow Lane, Las Vegas, Dennis Hill, 1201 Shadow Lane, Las Vegas, Nev.; Hugh M. Baldwin, Bx. 205, Eureka, Nevada; E. C. Leutzinger, Bx. 327, Eureka, Nevada.

The said claim was located on the 14th day of July, A. D. 1969, and is described in respect to approximately 5 1/2 miles Northeast of the town of Beowawe, Nevada.

The locator's claim Fifteen Hundred (1,500) feet in length

along the course of said vein or lode each way from the point of discovery with a width of Six Hundred (600-ft.) feet on each side of the center of the vein or lode along the entire length of said claim.

The dimensions and location of the discovery shaft work is: The discovery work has been performed about 250-feet Southeast of the discovery monument, and is a backhoe excavation of the following approximate dimensions: 7' wide, 9' long, and 4 1/2 feet deep.

and the location and description of each corner with the markings thereon are as follows:

The Northeast corner is marked by a 4' x 4' White Post 4' feet high inscribed NE. COR. corner of BLACKHAWK #3 mine:

the Northwest corner is marked by a 4' x 4' White Post 4' feet high inscribed NW. COR. corner of BLACKHAWK #3 mine.

The Southeast corner is marked by a 4' x 4' White Post 4' feet high, inscribed SE. COR. corner BLACKHAWK #3 mine; the Southwest corner is marked by a 4' x 4' White Post 4' feet high, inscribed SW. COR. corner

BLACKHAWK #3 mine. There is a 4' x 4' White Post, out 300-ft from the center of the claim as side-centers, at each corner of each line. The discovery work has been done and the location work completed since July 29th, A. D. 1969.
