

Certificate of Location

THIS IS TO CERTIFY that the BEOWAVE # 7 lode mining claim was located by E.L. CLEVELAND and DENNIS HILL on the 24th day of JULY, 1969.

The general course of said lode or vein is NORTH & SOUTH

The claim is situated in the BEOWAVE Mining District, EUREKA County, State of Nevada,

The locator's claim 750 feet in a(n) Northerly direction and 750 feet in a(n) Southerly direction from the point of discovery, with a width of 300-feet feet on each side of the center of the vein or lode along the entire length of said claim.

The dimensions and locations of the discovery work done on the claim are as follows:
A backhoe trench of the following approximate dimensions:-
4.5 in width; 20.0 feet in length, and 5.5 feet in depth.

The corners and side centers of the claim are located and marked as follows:
4" x 4" White post, marked, East Side Center of Beowave #7.
4" x 4" White post, marked, West Side Center of Beowave #7.
4" x 4" White post, marked, Northwest Corner of Beowave #7.
4" x 4" White post, marked, Northeast Corner of Beowave #7.
4" x 4" White post, marked, Southwest Corner of Beowave #7.
4" x 4" White post, marked, Southeast Corner of Beowave #7.

Each of the above-described monuments is a four-by-four white post, four-feet above ground level, with top eight-inches of said posts painted blue. This claim is approximately 1-mile South of the Courthouse in Beowave, and is in the SE $\frac{1}{4}$ of Sec. 6, T.31N., R. 49E., MDB&M.

All location and discovery work necessary to complete this location had been performed by September 12th, 1969.
