CERTIFICATE OF LOCATION OF LODE CLAIM

THIS IS TO CERTIFY that the W-22 Lode Mining Claim was located by Wm. L. Wilson on the 26th day of July 1969. The general course of said vein or lode is northerly and southerly. The claim is situate in the Secret Canyon Area of the Eureka (unorganized) Mining District, Eureka County, Nevada.

The Locator claims 1450 feet in a northerly direction and 50 feet in a southerly direction from the location monument, and a width of 300 feet on each side of the center of the vein or lode along the entire length of said claim.

In compliance with Sections 517.040, 517.050 and other applicable portions of the Nevada Revised Statutes, the discovery work consisted of a Rotary Drill Hole, located approximately 120 feet N 77° E of the west side center, W-20 claim. The total depth of this hole is 225 feet. In addition, a drill site was prepared.

This claim is one of a group of eight contiguous claims, being the W-20, W-21, W-22, W-23, W-24, W-25, W-26, and W-27, for whose benefit the discover; work described above was performed. More than \$800.00 was expended for said drilling on said group of 8 claims, which did advance the exploration and development of all claims in said group.

Each corner or side center of said claim is marked with a 4" x 4" wooden post, 4½ feet long, set one foot of its length in the ground, said posts being located and marked (markings are on metal tags affixed to said posts) as follows (bearings and distances are approximate): "SW COR W- 22 "; thence northerly for a distance of 750 feet to a post marked, "WSC W- 22 "; thence northerly for a distance of 750 feet to a post marked, "NW COR W- 22 "; thence easterly for a distance of 600 feet to a post marked, "NE COR W- 22 "; thence southerly for a distance of 750 feet to a post marked, "ESC W- 22"; thence southerly for a distance of 750 feet to a post marked, "ESC W- 22"; thence westerly for a distance of 600 feet to the point of beginning.

The northwest corner of this claim is approximately 2,910 feet N 30°E from the Windfall Mine Shaft, which shaft is on the patented Windfall Claim, U. S. Survey No. 3705, Eureka County, Nevade

All location and discovery work necessary to complete this location have been performed by October 14, 1969.
