

# CERTIFICATE OF LOCATION

Revised Laws, Sec. 2424

The Undersigned, hereby certifies that he has located a mining claim in the Eureka Mining District, County of Eureka, State of Nevada, on a vein or lode known as the JEWEL # 10.

The general course of said lode or vein, as near as it may be described, is North & South.

The name of the locator is E. L. Cleveland, 1201 Shadow Lane, Las Vegas, Nev.

The said claim was located on the 3rd day of September A. D. 1969, and is described in respect to\* Approximately 1.2--miles North of the Dunderberg Mine in Goodwin Canyon.

The locator claims: 1500 feet in length

along the course of said vein or lode each way from the point of discovery with a width of 300 feet on each side of the center of the vein or lode along the entire length of said claim.

The dimensions and location of the discovery shaft work is:

A dozer excavation of the following approximate size:-

The Southeast corner is marked by 4" x 4" White Post 4 feet high, inscribed S. E. Cor. corner Jewel # 10 mine: the Southwest corner

is marked by a 4" x 4" White Post 4 feet high, inscribed S.W. Cor. corner Jewel # 10 mine. There is a White post of same above size located

at each side center of claim at each corner of each line. The discovery work has been done and the location work completed since
