The northwest corner is marked by a 4" X 4" POST 4'6" feet high, inscribed "NW Corner of the SILVER BOY Claim"; the southwest corner is marked by a 4" X 4" POST 4'6" feet high, inscribed "SW Corner of the SILVER BOY Claim"; the southeast corner is marked by a 4" X 4" POST 4'6" feet high, inscribed "SE Corner of the SILVER BOY Claim"; the northeast corner is marked by a 4" X 4" POST 4'6" feet high, inscribed "NE Corner of the SILVER BOY Claim." There is also a 4" X 4" POST at the center of each side line. (Use reverse side for multiple locations.)

Each of the described monuments is a post at least 4 inches in diameter by 4 feet 6 inches in length set 1 foot in the ground.

All discovery and location work necessary to complete the E location has been performed by NOV 1st, 1969.
