

Certificate of Location

This Is to Certify, That a mining claim named the PAL was located by

Blaine C. Hoalst

on the 11th day of September 1969, situated in
Lynn Creek District, Eureka County, State of
Nevada, and about This claim crosses Lynn Creek and is bounded on the East
by the Holt Patent # 4422, the location of the Monument is approx. 210°N55°W to
cabin. and on bar near Pond.

(Refer to some natural object or permanent monument)

I claim 1500 linear feet along the course of
 mineral bearing ledge, lode or vein, extending 200 feet from the
 location monument in a Northerly direction, and 1300
 feet in a Southerly direction, together with 600 feet
 on each side of the center of the ledge for the entire length of the claim.

The discovery work consists of Trench and two cuts

(Shaft, cut or tunnel)

situated about 100' Approx. feet in a Easterly direction from the location
 monument and its dimensions are, 23' feet wide, 4' feet high,
8' feet long and 4' feet deep, exposing ledge, lode or vein in place.

The northwest corner is marked by a 4"X4"X4 1/2" Post feet high, inscribed
"N. W. corner Pal Mine"; the southwest corner is marked by a
4"X4"X4 1/2" Post feet high, inscribed "S. W. corner Pal
Mine"; the southeast corner is marked by a 4"X4"X4 1/2" Post feet high,
 inscribed "S. E. corner Pal Mine"; the northeast corner is
 marked by a 4"X4"X4 1/2" Post feet high, inscribed "N. E. corner
Pal Mine." There is also a 4"X4"X4 1/2" Post at
 the center of each side line. The discovery work has been done and the location completed

since November 30th 1969.
