

# Certificate of Location

THIS IS TO CERTIFY that the H & G No. 47 lode mining claim was located by SACKS, W. GRIMM on the 2nd day of November, 1909.

The general course of said lode or vein is Northwesterly and southeasterly.

The claim is situated in the Alpha Mining District, Eureka County, State of Nevada, T. 24 N., R. 56 E., near the Prince of Wales Mine.

The locator claim 25 feet in a(n) N. 55° W. direction and 1875 feet in a(n) S. 55° E. direction from the point of discovery, with a width of 120 feet on each side of the center of the vein or lode along the entire length of said claim.

The dimensions and locations of the discovery work done on the claim are as follows: Access made and grill also preparations over a contiguous group of fifty claims. The work for a contiguous group of claim is done on H & G No. 47 and No. 50 for a group consisting of H & G No. 47 through No. 50. No. 47 and No. 49

The corners and side centers of the claim are located and marked as follows: The southeast corner is marked by a 4 x 4' x 4' post inscribed SW Corner of the H & G No. 47, the southwest corner is marked by a 4 x 4' x 4' post inscribed SW Corner of the H & G No. 47, the southeast corner is marked by a 4 x 4' x 4' post inscribed SE Corner of H & G No. 47; the northwest corner is marked by a 4 x 4' x 4' post inscribed NW Corner of the H & G No. 47. There is also a 4 x 4' x 4' post at the center of each side line.

Each of the above-described monuments is 4" x 6" x 4" post buried one foot in the ground.

All location and discovery work necessary to complete this location had been performed by William Grimm, 1909.
