

## CERTIFICATE OF LOCATION

Revised Laws, Sec. 2421

The Undersigned, hereby certifies that he has located a mining claim in the Secret Canyon, County of Eureka, State of Nevada, on a vein or lode known as the Willie.

The general course of said lode or vein, as near as it may be described, is North - South.

The name of the locator Frank Foster

The said claim was located on the 9 day of November, A.D. 1969, and is described in respect to 1 mile South of Goldie's Portland Dumps & between Secret & Potato Canyons.

The locator claims 1500 feet in length with 50' S.E. of 1450' N.W. of discovery monument,

along the course of said vein or lode each way from the point of discovery with a width of 700 feet on each side of the center of the vein or lode along the entire length of said claim.

The dimensions and location of the discovery shaft work is excavation & drivings located on Willie # 4, 6, 8, 22 & 23,

and the location and description of each corner with the markings thereon are as follows:

The West corner is marked by a post 4' feet high, inscribed West corner of Willie # 4 mine.

The North corner is marked by a post 4' feet high, inscribed North corner of Willie # 4 mine.

The East corner is marked by a post 4' feet high, inscribed East corner of Willie # 4 mine, the South corner is marked by a post 4' feet high, inscribed South corner of Willie # 4 mine.

There is a post on the side center of each claim road at each corner of each line. The discovery work has been done and the location work completed since 16 Dec.
