

## CERTIFICATE OF LOCATION

The Undersigned, hereby certifies that he has located a mining claim in the Secret Canyon, County of Eureka, State of Nevada, on a vein or lode known as the W.M. #21.

The general course of said lode or vein, as near as it may be described, is North - South.

The said claim was located on the 9 day of November A.D. 1969, and is described in respect to 1 mile South of Goddard Rock and Dumps & between Secret & Roto Canyons.

The locator claim 1300 feet in length, Width 250' S.E. of ~~the~~ NO'NE of discovery monument.

The East corner is marked by post 4' feet high & inscribed East corner W.M. #21 mine. the South corner is marked by a post 4' feet high inscribed South.

W.M. #21 mine. There is a post on the side center of each of the 4 sides at each corner of each line. The discovery work has been done and the location work completed since 16 Dec.
