 A trench equivalent to a 4' X 6' X 10' cut was made near
 the discovery monument of U.P. #8.

 southwest corner, a post marked SW UP-8, 750' in a northerly
 direction to the west side center (WSC UP -8), thence 750'
 northerly to the NW corner (NW UP-8), thence 600' east to
 the NE corner (NE UP-8), thence 750' south to the east side
 center (ESC UP-8), thence 750' south to the SE corner
 (SE UP -8), thence 600' west to the SW corner (SW UP-8),
 the point of beginning.

Each of the above-described monuments is a post at least 4" in diameter by
 4.5' in length, set 1' in the ground.
