Attached hereto and hereby referred to and by this reference made a part of this affidavit is a ground magnetic map showing the actual location of the claims boundaries, corner and discovery monuments and the results of the magnetic survey as performed on the ground within the boundaries of the claims group, which map is designated as Exhibit I.


Although prior affidavits of annual assessment work recite that, in addition to certain physical work done on the claims, additional geophysical, geochemical and/or geologic work was done, proof of such work was not in compliance with 72 Stat. 1701; 30 U.S.C. 28-1-2. Because all former geophysical, geochemical and/or geologic work was in addition to physical assessment work necessary to hold the claims and did not comply with applicable federal laws, the geological-geophysical work relied upon for this affidavit is the first such work done in compliance with applicable laws for the purpose of holding such claims.

Said work was performed and improvements made at the instance and request of Swiss Oils of Canada (1959) Ltd. for the benefit of said claims group and had a value in excess of One Hundred (\$100.00) Dollars for each claim.

Said labor was performed and improvements made between 12:00 o'clock Meridian on September 1, 1969 and 12:00 o'clock Meridian on June 17, 1970.



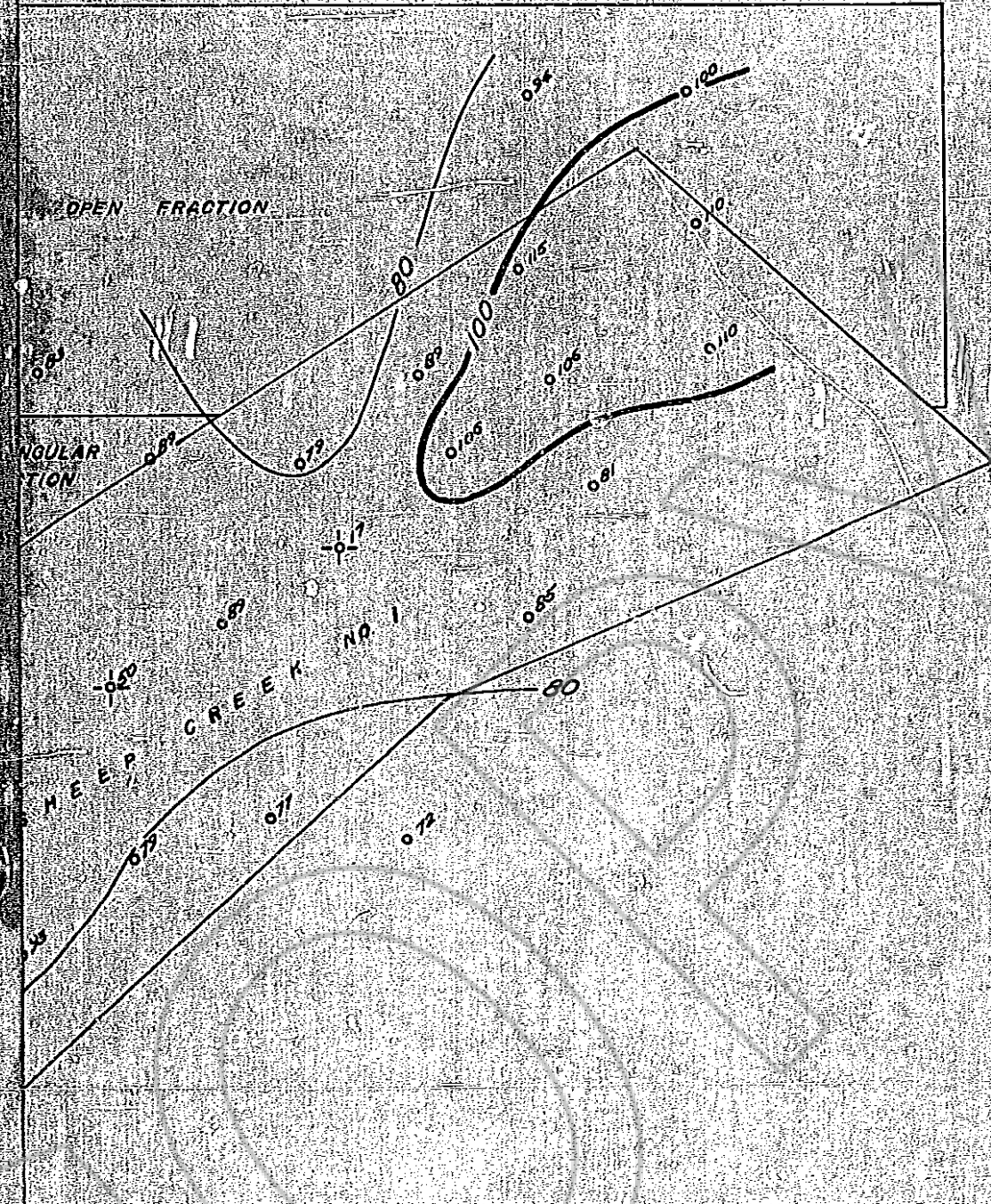

SECTIONS 11 & 14

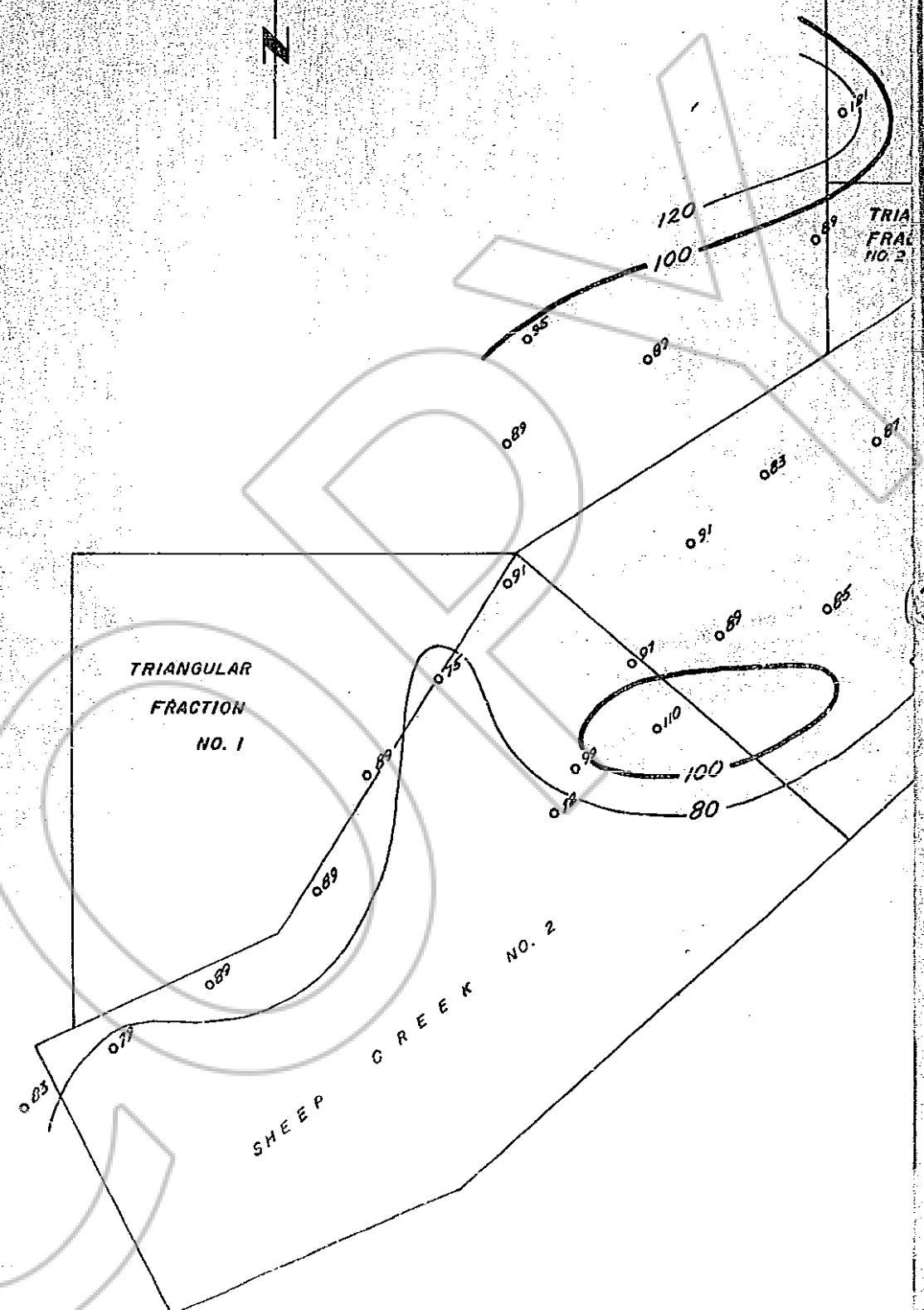
