

# Certificate of Location of Lode Mining Claim

THIS IS TO CERTIFY that the Homestead No. 2 Lode Mining Claim was located by Archie Allison whose post office address appears below, on the 6 day of August, 1970.  
 The general course of said lode or vein is Northerly & Southerly.  
 The claim is situated in the FUTURE Mining District, Eureka County, State of Nevada,

The locator..... claims 750 feet in a Southerly direction and 750 feet in a Northerly direction from the point of discovery, with a width of 300 feet on each side of the center of the vein or lode along the entire length of said claim.

The dimensions and locations of the discovery work done on the claim are as follows:  
from center location post easterly about 50 feet  
an open cut ± 5 feet deep, about ± 8' wide, and about 10' long

The total cost of such work consisted of at least \$ 100.00

The corners and side centers of the claim are located and marked as follows:

From the NW corner, a monument marked NW Cor Cor., thence in a easterly direction 600 feet to the NE corner, a monument marked NE Cor Cor., thence 750 feet in a Southerly direction to the Easterly side center, a monument marked E side SC, thence 750 feet in a southerly direction to the SE corner, a monument marked SE Cor Cor., thence 600 feet in a westerly direction to the SW corner, a monument marked SW Cor Cor., thence 750 feet in a Northerly direction to the westerly side center, a monument marked W side SC, thence 750 feet Northerly to the point of beginning.

Each of the above-described monuments is 4" x 4" post 4 1/2 feet long

All location and discovery work necessary to complete this location had been performed by August 29, 1970.
