# CERTIFICATE OF LOCATION

## LODE-QUARTZ

THIS IS TO CERTIFY that the TWIN SPRINGS No. 14 lode mining claim was located by:

on the 21<sup>ST</sup> day of JUNE, 1970, situated in the UN-NAMED Mining District, EUREKA County, State of NEVADA, and about 1300 FEET NORTHEASTERLY FROM GENERAL LAND SURVEY MONUMENTS MARKING CORNERS OF SECTIONS 2, 35 AND SECTIONS 3, 34; T19N, R45E AND 600 FEET WESTERLY OF TWIN SPRINGS NO. 13 LOCATION POST.

We (or) claim 1500 linear feet along the course of the mineral-bearing ledge, lode or vein, extending 1470 feet from the location monument in a NORTHERLY direction, and 30 feet in a SOUTHERLY direction, together with 300 feet on each side of the center of the ledge for the entire length of the claim.

The discovery work consists of a BULLDOZER CUT located about 5 feet in a SOUTHERLY direction from the location monument, and its dimensions are 6 feet wide, 25 feet long and 4 feet deep, exposing ledge, lode or vein in place.

The northwest corner is marked by a 4x4" POST - 4 feet high, inscribed "NW Corner of the T.S. #14 Claim;" the southwest corner is marked by a 4x4" POST - 4 feet high, inscribed "SW Corner of the T.S. #14 Claim;" the southeast corner is marked by a 4x4" POST - 4 feet high, inscribed "SE Corner of the T.S. #14 Claim;" the northeast corner is marked by a 4x4" POST - 4 feet high, inscribed "NE Corner of the T.S. #14 Claim." There is also a 4x4" POST at the center of each side line. The discovery work has been done, and the location completed since JULY 20<sup>TH</sup>, 1970.
