Certificate of Location of Lode Claim

the East West corner is marked by a 4x4x4" Post

feet high, inscribed East West corner Purple Vein Claim mining claim;

the South West corner is marked by a 4x4x4" Post

feet high, inscribed South West corner Purple Vein claim mining claim.

There is also a 4x4x4" Post at the center of each side line. The discovery work has been done and the location completed 4 Sept, 1970.
