Certificate of Location of Lode Claim

THIS IS TO CERTIFY that a Lode Mining Claim named the Purple Vein Claim No. 5

on the 9 day of June, 1920, that it is situated in

Waharaw Mining District Eureka County,

State of Nevada, and about 12 mi. distant from Lyon Creek

as near as known from present developments; and that 1 claim(s) 1500 linear feet along the course of the mineral bearing ledge, lode, vein or deposit extending 300 feet from the location monument in a Eastly direction, and 300 feet in a Westly direction, together with Three Hundred feet in width on each side of the ledge for the entire length of the claim.

The discovery work consists of Cuts and Bulldozing

situated about 10 feet in a Northly direction from the location monument, and its dimensions are 15 feet wide 15 feet long and 4 feet deep, exposing the ledge, vein or mineral deposit. Total cost of said work was \$ 100.00

This claim was monumented on the 9 day of June, 1920

The North East corner is marked by a 4x4x4'6" Post

feet high, inscribed North East corner Purple Vein Claim mining claim; the North West corner is marked by a 4x4x4'6" Post

feet high, inscribed North West corner Purple Vein Claim mining claim; the East West corner is marked by a 4x4x4'6" Post

feet high, inscribed East West corner Purple Vein Claim mining claim; the South West corner is marked by a 4x4x4'6" Post

feet high, inscribed South West corner Purple Vein Claim mining claim.

There is also a 4x4x4'6" Post at the center of each side line. The discovery work has been done and this location completed 9 Sept., 1920
