Certificate of Location

THIS IS TO CERTIFY that the Heatherbell lode mining claim was located by Mrs. George Martin and R. H. Carter on the 15th day of October, 1970.

The general course of said lode or vein is North & South.

The claim is situated in the Unknown Mining District, Eureka County, State of Nevada, and lies about 200 feet North of Vernonia Creek.

The locator's claim 1500 feet in a(n) Northerly direction and 200 feet in a(n) Southerly direction from the point of discovery, with a width of 200 feet on each side of the center of the vein or lode along the entire length of said claim.

The dimensions and locations of the discovery work done on the claim are as follows:
a Trench 3 ft. deep, 12 ft. wide across the entire width of the claim.

The corners and side centers of the claim are located and marked as follows:
The Northwest corner is marked by a Stake, inscribed "NW Corner Heatherbell Claim".
The Southwest corner is marked by a Stake, inscribed "SW Corner Heatherbell Claim".
The Southeast corner is marked by a Stake, inscribed "SE Corner Heatherbell Claim".
The Northeast corner is marked by a Stake, inscribed "NE Corner Heatherbell Claim".
There is a Stake at the center of the West sideline, inscribed "West Side Center Heatherbell Claim", and also a Stake at the Center of the East sideline, inscribed "East Side Center Heatherbell Claim".

Each of the above-described monuments is a 4" x 4" post.

All location and discovery work necessary to complete this location had been performed by October 16, 1970.
