

Certificate of Location of Lode Mining Claim

THIS IS TO CERTIFY that the ACE No. 21 Lode Mining Claim was located by William D. Collins, whose post office address appears below, on the 14th day of September 1970.

The general course of said lode or vein is North and South.

The claim is situated in the Mineral Hill Mining District, Persia County, State of Nevada, in the SW 1/4 Sec. 14 and NW 1/4 Sec. 21, T. 26 N., R. 52 E.

The locator staked 1450 feet in a northerly direction and 50 feet in a southerly direction from the point of discovery, with a width of 300 feet on each side of the center of the vein or lode along the entire length of said claim.

The dimensions and locations of the discovery work done on the claim are as follows: 700' of road built diagonally southwest across the south half of ACE No. 18 terminating in a drill site about 200' N 30° E of the southwest corner of the claim where a 150' deep hole was drilled, and 300' of road near the west side center of ACE No. 19. The two named claims along with ACE No. 20, ACE No. 21, ACE No. 22, ACE No. 23, ACE No. 24, ACE No. 16, ACE No. 15, and ACE No. 32 form a contiguous group of ten claims for which discovery work on any one applies for all. (Section 317.040 (2) Nevada Revised Statutes, 1959)

The total cost of such work consisted of at least \$ 1000.00 (\$ None) EXTRAPOLATE on ACE No. 21.)

The corners and side centers of the claim are located and marked as follows:

From the northwest corner, a monument marked ACE No. 21, NE Cor, thence in an easterly direction 600 feet to the northeast corner, a monument marked ACE No. 21, NE Cor, thence 750 feet in a southerly direction to the east side center, a monument marked ACE No. 21, E. 80, thence 750 feet in a southerly direction to the southeast corner, a monument marked ACE No. 21, SE Cor, thence 600 feet in a westerly direction to the southwest corner, a monument marked ACE No. 21, SW Cor, thence 750 feet in a northerly direction to the NE Cor, the point of beginning.

Each of the above described monuments is a 4x4 post 4'6" long planted 1" in the ground. All location and discovery work necessary to complete this location had been performed by November 11, 1970.
