

Certificate of Location of Lode Mining Claim

THIS IS TO CERTIFY that the ACE No. 34 Lode Mining Claim was located by William D. Collins, whose post office address appears below, on the 18th day of September, 1970.

The general course of said lode or vein is north and south.

The claim is situated in the Mineral Hill Mining District, Bureka County, State of Nevada, in the NE 1/4 Sec. 15 and SE 1/4 Sec. 10, T. 26 N., R. 52 E.

The header claim is 50 feet in a northwesterly direction and 1450 feet in a southerly direction from the point of discovery, with a width of 300 feet on each side of the center of the vein or lode along the entire length of said claim.

The dimensions and locations of the discovery work done on the claim are as follows: 200' of road built near the east side center of ACE No. 1, 2700' angling northeast across ACE No. 2 in three places, 1700' on ACE No. 35 near the south edge and across the north one-third, 1200' on ACE No. 34 along the south edge and the north one-third 1000' on ACE No. 33 along the south edge and the northeast corner, 600' on ACE No. 53 along the south edge, 200' on ACE No. 54 in the southeast corner, 1300' on ACE No. 36 across the middle and the north one-third, and 1000' in the northwest corner of ACE No. 37. The named claims, along with ACE No. 60, form a contiguous block of ten claims for which discovery work applies. (Section 517.040 (2) Nevada Revised Statutes, 1957)

The total cost of such work consisted of at least \$ 1000.00 (\$ 100.00 at least on ACE No. 34.)

The corners and the centers of the claim are located and marked as follows:

From the northwest corner, a monument marked ACE No. 34 NW Cor., thence in an easterly direction 600 feet to the northeast corner, a monument marked ACE No. 34 NE Cor., thence 750 feet in a southerly direction to the east side corner, a monument marked ACE No. 34 E SC, thence 750 feet in a southerly direction to the southeast corner, a monument marked ACE No. 34 SE Cor., thence 600 feet in a westerly direction to the southwest corner, a monument marked ACE No. 34 SW Cor., thence 750 feet in a norttherly direction to the west side corner, a monument marked ACE No. 34 W SC, thence 750 feet norttherly to the point of beginning.

Each of the above-described monuments is a 4X6 post 4'6" long planted 1' in the ground.

All location and discovery work necessary to complete this location had been performed by November 11, 1970.
