

Certificate of Location of Lode Mining Claim

THIS IS TO CERTIFY that the ACE No. 48 Lode Mining Claim 702
located by William D. Collins, whose post office address appears
below, on the 24th day of September, in 1950

The general course of said claim or vein is north and south.

The claim is situated in the Mineral Hill Mining District, Eureka
County, State of Nevada, in the NW 1/4 and SW 1/4 of Sec. 10, T. 26 N., R. 52 E.

The center claim is 1650 feet in a northward direction and 50 feet in a southward direction from the point of discovery, with a width of 300 feet on each side of the center of the vein or lode along the entire length of said claim.

The dimensions and locations of the discovery work done on the claim are as follows: 600' of road built across the south one-third of ACE No. 48, 500' near the south end of ACE No. 47, 1100' in the west two-thirds of the north one-third of ACE No. 40 and 600' across the north one-third of ACE No. 46. A drill hole 260' deep was drilled approximately 600' S 30° W of the northeast corner of ACE No. 40. The four named claims along with ACE No. 38, ACE No. 39, ACE No. 56, ACE No. 57, ACE No. 58 and ACE No. 59 form a contiguous group on which discovery work on any one claim applies to all. (Section 517.040 (2) Nevada Revised Statutes, 1957)

The total cost of such work consisted of at least \$ 1000.00 (\$ 75.00 at least on ACE No. 48).

The corners and side centers of the claim are located and marked as follows:

From the northwest corner, a monument marked ACE No. 48 NW Cor. thence in an easterly direction 600 feet to the northeast corner, a monument marked ACE No. 48, NE Cor. thence 750 feet in a southerly direction to the east side center, a monument marked ACE No. 48, E. 50, thence 750 feet in a southerly direction to the southeast corner, a monument marked ACE No. 48, SE Cor. thence 500 feet in a westerly direction to the southwest corner, a monument marked ACE No. 48, SW Cor. thence 750 feet in a northward direction to the west side center, a monument marked ACE No. 48, W. 50, thence 750 feet northward to the point of beginning.

Each of the above described monuments is a 6x6 post 4'6" long planted 1' in the ground.

All location and discovery work necessary to establish this location had been performed by November 11, 1950.
