

Certificate of Location of Lode Mining Claim

THIS IS TO CERTIFY that the ACE No. 50 Lode Mining Claim was located by William D. Collins, whose post office address appears below, on the 20th day of September, in 70.

The general course of said lode or vein is north and south.

The vein is situated in the Mineral Hill Mining District, Eureka County, State of Nevada, in the SE 1/4 Sec. 10, T. 26 N., R. 52 E.

The locator claim 1450 feet is in a northwesterly direction and 50 feet in a southerly direction from the point of discovery, with a width of 300 feet on each side of the center of the vein or lode along the entire length of said claim.

The dimensions and locations of the discovery work done on the claim are as follows: 1000' of road built along the north edge and in the northeast quarter of ACE No. 52 and a drill hole 155' deep located about 450' S 15° W of the northeast corner of ACE No. 52, 600' of road built across the north one-third of ACE No. 51, 2700' across the middle end down the center lengthwise of ACE No. 50, 600' across the middle of ACE No. 49, and 800' starting at the west side center and finishing near the south end center of ACE No. 41. These five named claims along with ACE No. 42, ACE No. 43, ACE No. 44, ACE No. 45, and ACE No. 55 form a contiguous group of ten claims upon which discovery work on any one applies to all. (Section 517.040 (2) Nevada Revised Statutes, 1957.)

The total cost of such work consisted of at least \$ 1000.00 (\$ 300.00 at least on ACE No. 50)

The corners and side centers of the claim are located and marked as follows:

From the northwest corner, a monument marked ACE No. 50 , NW Cor., thence in an easterly direction 600 feet to the northeast corner, a monument marked ACE No. 50 , NE Cor., thence 750 feet in a southerly direction to the east side center, a monument marked ACE No. 50 , E SC., thence 750 feet in a southerly direction to the southeast corner, a monument marked ACE No. 50 , SE Cor., thence 600 feet in a westerly direction to the southwest corner, a monument marked ACE No. 50 , SW Cor., thence 750 feet in a northerly direction to the west side center, a monument marked ACE No. 50 , W SC., thence 750 feet northerly to the point of beginning.

Each of the above-described monuments is a 4x4 post 4'6" long planted 1' in the ground.

All location and discovery work necessary to complete this horizon had been performed by November 11, in 70.
