CERTIFICATE OF APPROPRIATION OF WATER

WHEREAS Mark Chilton (Agent) has presented to the State Engineer of the State of Nevada Proof of Application of Water to Beneficial Use, from an underground source through drilled well, pump and stock tanks for stock watering purposes. The point of diversion of water from the source is as follows: NW 1/4 Sec. 5, T. 21 N., R. 53 E., M.D.B.&M., or at a point from which the SW corner of said Sec. 5 bears S. 11 degrees 27' W., a distance of 1,808 feet, situated in Eureka County, State of Nevada.

Now Know Ye, That the State Engineer, under the provisions of NRS 533.425, has determined the date, source, purpose, amount of appropriation, and the place where such water is appurtenant, as follows:

* Amount of appropriation 0.0078 c.f.s., or sufficient to water 150 hd. of cattle & 100 hd. of horses

Period of use, from January 1 to December 31 of each year

Date of priority of appropriation July 19, 1967

Description of works of diversion, manner and place of use:

Water is developed by means of hand dug well and is conveyed through a 2-inch pipeline to three 1,000 gallon stock watering tanks where it is used to water approximately 150 head of cattle and 100 head of horses within the NW 1/4 Sec. 5, T. 21 N., R. 53 E., M.D.B.&M.

* This certificate is issued subject to the terms of the permit.

SEAL

The right to water hereby determined is limited to the amount which can be beneficially used, not to exceed the amount above specified, and the use is restricted to the place and for the purpose as set forth herein.
