

**THE STATE OF NEVADA
CERTIFICATE OF APPROPRIATION OF WATER**

WHEREAS, Mark Chilton (Agent), has presented to the State Engineer of the State of Nevada Proof of Application of Water to Beneficial Use, from an underground source (Well No. 1S) through drilled well, pump, tank and distribution system for stockwatering and domestic purposes. The point of diversion of water from the source is as follows: NEW NEV Sec. 21, T. 21 N., R. 53 E., M.D.B.&M., or at a point from which the NE corner of said Sec. 21 bears N. 60 degrees 30' E., a distance of 1,400 feet, situated in Eureka County, State of Nevada.

Now Know Ye, That the State Engineer, under the provisions of NRS 533.425, has determined the date, source, purpose, amount of appropriation, and the place where such water is appurtenant, as follows:

* Amount of appropriation 2,000 head of cattle

Period of use, from January 1 to December 31 of each year

Date of priority of appropriation November 6, 1967

Description of works of diversion, manner and place of use:

Water is developed by means of a drilled well and conveyed to a 42 gallon pressure tank and then to three 2,000 gallon stock watering tanks where it is used to water approximately 2,000 head of cattle. The water is also conveyed to a house trailer and lawn where it is used for domestic purposes. All use is within the NEW NEV Sec. 21, R. 21 N., R. 53 E., M.D.B.&M.

This certificate is issued subject to the terms of the permit.

The right to water hereby determined is limited to the amount which can be beneficially used, not to exceed the amount above specified, and the use is restricted to the place and for the purpose as set forth herein.
