

THE STATE OF NEVADA CERTIFICATE OF APPROPRIATION OF WATER

WHEREAS Henry C. Conrad, Agent has presented to the State Engineer of the State of Nevada Proof of Application of Water to Beneficial Use, from

purposes: The point of diversion of water from the source is as follows: NE 1/4 Sec. 21, T. 17N., R. 53E., M.D.B. & M., or at a point from which the SE corner of Sec. 7, T. 16N., R. 53E., M.D.B. & M., bears S. 22° 53' W. a distance of 25,765 feet.

Water is developed from Cut Bank Wash and transported to a reservoir within portions of the SE 1/4 and NE 1/4 Sec. 21, T. 17N., R. 53E., where it is used to water 175 head of cattle.
