CERTIFICATE OF APPROPRIATION OF WATER

WHEREAS, Henry C. Conrad, Agent has presented to the State Engineer of the State of Nevada Proof of Application of Water to Beneficial Use, from Fish Creek Canyon through creek and reservoir for stockwatering purposes. The point of diversion of water from the source is as follows: SW¹SE⁴, Sec. 11, T.16N., R.52E. (unsurveyed) or at a point from which the SE corner of Sec. 7 T.16N., R.53E. bears S. 86° 38' 30" E. a distance of 13,093 feet. situated in Eureka County, State of Nevada.

NOW KNOW YE, That the State Engineer, under the provisions of NRS 533.425, has determined the date, source, purpose, amount of appropriation, and the place where such water is appurtenant, as follows:

Amount of appropriation 0.004375 c.f.s. or sufficient to water 140 cattle.

Period of use, from January 1st to December 31st of each year

Date of priority of appropriation May 29, 1968

Description of works of diversion, manner and place of use:

Water is developed from Fish Creek Canyon and thence conveyed to a reservoir within portions of the SE¹SW¹ and SW¹SE⁴, Sec. 11, T.16N., R.52E. M.D.B.&M., where it is used to water 140 head of cattle.

This certificate is issued subject to the terms of the permit.
